Supply Chain Risk & Resolution:

Removing Refurbished, Reconditioned, Repaired or Remanufactured Products

Background

FAS regularly contacts Schedule contractors to remove refurbished, reconditioned, repaired and remanufactured items from the contract. SCP-FSS-001 *Instructions Applicable to All Offerors (Mar 2022)* states that:

Remanufactured items are only allowable under specific MAS SINs and are designated as such by their Special Item Number (SIN) description. The remanufactured items must be identified per clause <u>552.238-78</u> and meet the prescribed definition of "factory rebuilt to original specifications".

Note: refurbished, reconditioned and repaired items are not within scope of the MAS Solicitation.

What Special Item Numbers (SIN) allow remanufactured Items?

The table below lists the SINs that allow remanufactured items. Note that remanufactured items must meet the definition of "factory rebuilt to original specifications" and be identified in accordance with <u>552.238-78</u> *Identification of Products that Have Environmental Attributes.*

What Special Item Numbers (SIN) allow refurbished, reconditioned or repaired items?

None. Refurbished, reconditioned, or repaired products are not within the scope of the MAS Solicitation.

Process

FAS will contact your company's point of contact for contract administration and authorized negotiators if GSA data indicates that remanufactured, refurbished, reconditioned, and/or repaired products are being improperly offered on your Schedule contract. FAS will remove these products from your MAS contract in accordance with 552.239-79 *Cancellation.*
