The <u>VSC Marking/ Labeling/ Packaging webpage</u> has been replaced with the Strategic Partner Delivery (SPD) webpage. This updated page includes all of the information vendors will need to ensure packages for GSA Federal and Military Customers and packages are prepared properly. All GSA vendors must adhere to <u>General Services Administration Acquisition Manual (GSAM) clause 552.211-73</u>, which stipulates all deliveries to military activities, including shipments and parcel delivery that go via the DLA transportation network, shall be compliant with MIL-STD-129R regulations. In addition, all deliveries to civilian activities shall be marked in accordance with Federal Standard 123.

The new Strategic Partner Delivery webpage is designed to help you understand what's required so you can prevent your packages from becoming delayed during the shipping process. The new webpage also includes examples of compliant labels, Answers to Frequently Asked Questions, guidance for compliant labels and packaging materials, and more...
